2024 DIMÎNÎSTRATIVÊ ORDER

Pursuant to N.C. General Statutes – Chapter 7A (as specified below)

Order under N.C.G.S. § 7A-41.1(c) and 7A-146

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and Chief District Court Judge under N.C.G.S. § 7A-41.1(c) and 7A—146:

- 1. After eCourts is officially implemented as of April 29, 2024, if pleadings or documents are filed with the Clerk of Superior Court with an incorrect designation or without a designation for Greensboro or High Point, the Clerk of Superior Court should be permitted to make said correction within fifteen (15) days of the filing of said pleading.
- 2. After fifteen days has passed, such a correction or designation should require permission from the Court.

IT IS ORDERED that the Guilford County Clerk of Superior Court may correct file designations regarding whether a case should be filed in High Point or Greensboro Court, as follows:

- After eCourts is officially implemented as of April 29, 2024, if pleadings or documents are filed with the Clerk of Superior Court with an incorrect designation or without a designation for Greensboro or High Point, the Clerk of Superior Court should be permitted to make said correction within fifteen (15) days of the filing of said pleading.
- 2. After fifteen days has passed, such a correction or designation should require permission from the Court.
- 3. This order supersedes any previous order issued by the undersigned or any prior Senior Resident Superior Court Judge or Chief District Court Judge regarding the matter contained herein. This order is effective upon filing in the Office of the Superior Court and shall remain in full force and effect until modified or rescinded by the undersigned Senior Resident Court Judge or Chief District Court Judge, or anyone who may hold the position.
