THE COURT ORDERS:

- THAT THE DEFENDANT'S PROBATION BE REVOKED
- THAT THE DEFENDANT BE CONTINUED ON PROBATION
- THAT THE COURT EXTENDS THE DEFENDANT'S PERIOD OF PROBATION _____ MONTHS TO COMPLY WITH MONETARY OR TREATMENT GOALS OF PROBATION.
