Now therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that upon filing a new action via File and Serve, Attorneys are required to designate a filing location by typing it into the filing description to indicate either Greensboro or High Point and if one is not selected, the filed document(s) will be filed in Greensboro by default as the county seat, which may subject the filing to be transferred or dismissed at a later date. This order is effective immediately.
